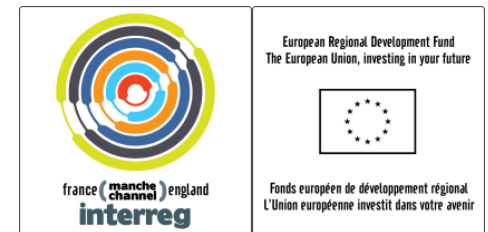

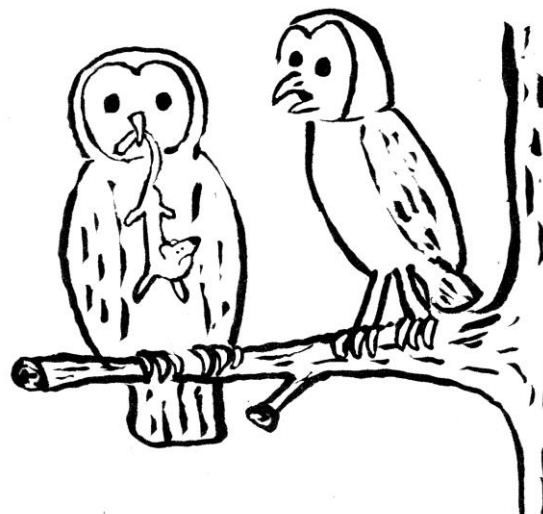

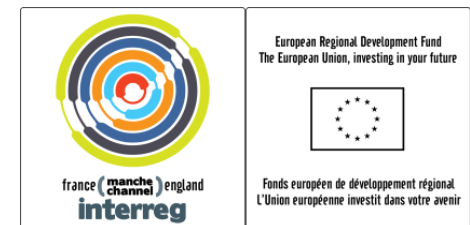

e.g. Rio Earth Summit, Climate Change Act, UK Renewable Energy Roadmap, technology advances in tidal devices, 2013/14 flooding

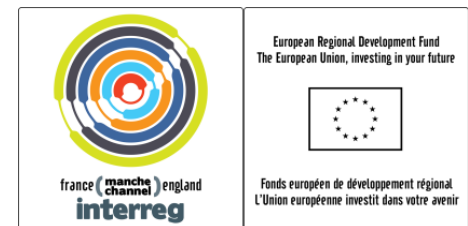


Think about the changes in activities which will be caused by this scenario:

a) to the intensity of the activity – will it stay the same, increase or decrease?

b) to the location of those activities – will it stay in the same place, or move? At what intensity?

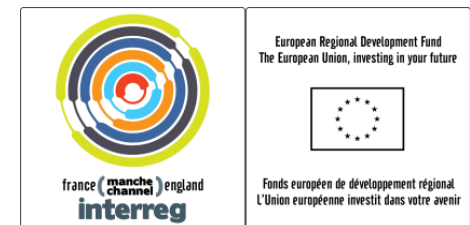
c) will any new activities take place? If so where? At what intensity?



Intensity: Ilfracombe Port expands to service array. Fishing stays the same, but relocates. Divers stop visiting area – decrease. Surfing in Ilfracombe decreases.

Location: Displacement of fishing activities due to exclusion zone, increase in intensity in other areas, fishing and dive/angling boats quit business to service the array – boat transport focused between Ilfracome and the site.

New activities: Construction and maintenance shipping from Ilfracombe to site – heavy. Tourism – pleasure boats to view the turbine array – light



Don't panic! There is a proforma to fill out, and we will be with you to help.

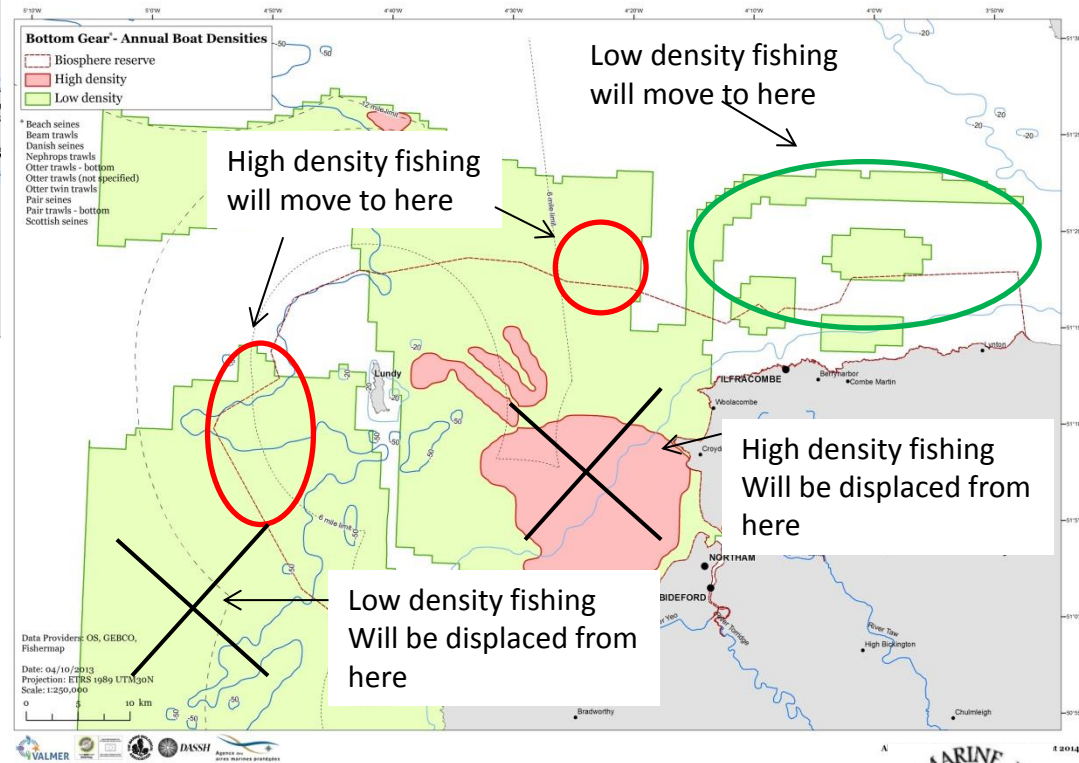
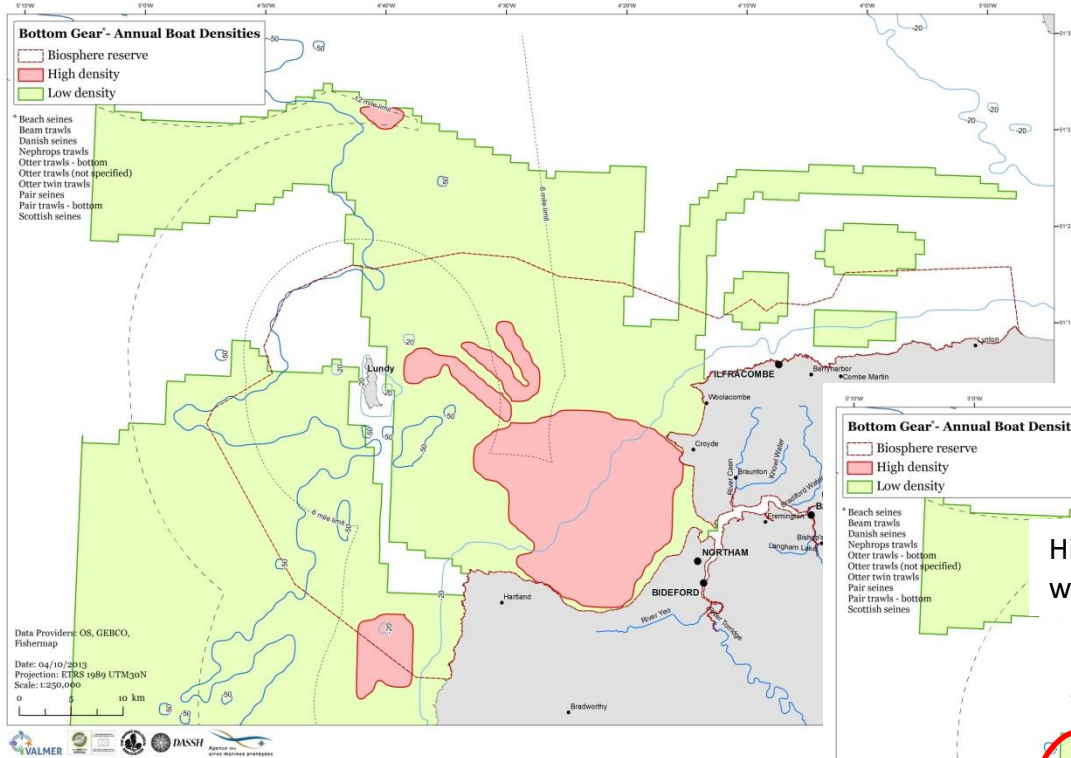
For each change in activity, we also need to MAP its location and intensity. There is a tick box on the proforma to remind you which map the activity will need to go on.

Use a red pen for high intensity, and a green pen for lower intensity. Black for other details
