How does ESA&V affect the governance process?

<u>Aim</u>: Monkor / measure how the VALMER process produces an evolution at the case study level. apture at different moments of the project, case study stakeholders' perception and understanding of FAAR.

#### Methods:

#### ) Stakeholder surveys (\*2)

- Before the beginning of the ESA&V process, i.e. prior to stakeholders being informed about the concept (during a site workshop, mail or by phone depending on the sites)
- After the implementation of the ESA&V, after having informed the stakeholders about the results of the ESA&V (during a site workshop, mail or by phone depending on the sites)

b) Case study coordinator surveys (\*2)

c) Focus group

How does ESA&V affect the governance outcomes?

Assess impact of ESA&V on Case Study governance i.e. how management orientated outputs / 'action plans' are developed by stakeholders using ESA&V. Identify lessons learnt & challenges.


